

Silver Blades Figure Skating Club
Show Try-Out
Policies and Procedures

- Senior skaters will automatically qualify for a feature in the show.
 - Senior skaters and will have the option of performing a routine in front of the judges in order to be considered for a solo.
- Skaters in ISI Freestyle Levels 4 and above will have the opportunity to try-out for a feature show part.
- During the first month of the Silver Blades season, all skaters will be provided with the judges score sheet, including criterion for the skating that will be evaluated during feature try-outs.
 - The Silver Blades Board will develop the criterion used by the judges.
 - The judges will be approved by Show Committee, with the preference to be 3 judges with skating backgrounds.
- Skaters trying-out for a feature part will be required to complete an application form.
- At that time skaters will be informed as to the number of feature/solo parts available.
 - In the event of a tie, additional feature parts may be added.
 - If additions are made, these will be announced at the same time as the final show parts are announced.
- On the day following try-outs, skaters will be provided with a list of those who successfully obtained a feature/solo part. This does not include the actual feature/solo assignment.
 - The Show Committee will be present during the tabulation of scores and the Show Committee will finalize the results prior to announcement.
 - The Show Director has the responsibility of assigning the actual solo and feature parts.
 - The Judges will be located in the overhead scorekeepers area.
 - Only judges and music player will be permitted in the judging area.
- In the event of an emergency where the skater is unable to perform on the established try-out date, with prior Show Committee approval, an audition may be videotaped by a designee of the Show Committee for consideration by the same panel of judges.

The Show Committee reserves the right, in extremely rare situations,
to grant exceptions to the above policy.
